RE: Public Meeting for the Watterson Trail Bicycle/Pedestrian Trail Project

Dear Jeffersontown Neighbor,

The City of Jeffersontown and BTM Engineers, Architects, Planners are working towards a plan to construct a multi-use bicycle/pedestrian trail along Watterson Trail from Stonybrook Drive to Ruckiegel Parkway. The approximately length will be 1.3 miles and will function independently of Watterson Trail. This trail will link several Jeffersontown neighborhoods to our town center. Downtown Jeffersontown is the economic hub for the community providing retail, commercial and governmental services. The scope of the project includes a 10-foot asphalt trail parallel to Watterson Trail and will serve to provide the pedestrian as well as the bicycle connection to the downtown and the Bluegrass Commerce Park and the City's recreational parks. These improvements will enhance the aesthetics of the corridor as well as provide a safer and more functional thoroughfare. We have been working with our consultant to explore various options for this trail segment and we would like to share the vision for the Watterson Trail Corridor Bicycle/Pedestrian Trail with you at an informal meeting to give you the opportunity to review the proposed design plans and provide feedback to the City of Jeffersontown and its representatives.


